

Rain causes second landslide near Requa Inn

For the second time in two weeks, a landslide shut down the community near Requa Road in Klamath on Friday.

The slide knocked out power to the area overnight and was cleared by crews early Saturday morning, said Del Norte County Office of Emergency Services Manager Cindy Henderson. Henderson said the slide, smaller than the one earlier this month, took out a power line and blocked the road leading up to the historic Requa Inn.

The area remains open to controlled one-way traffic while crews continue to work under rainy skies to clear the slides.
