

Officials watching 6 San Pablo homes after slide

SAN PABLO -- San Pablo officials are keeping a close watch on several homes after a landslide washed away the backyards of six of the homes.

Assistant City Manager Kelsey Worthy says building inspectors will be checking on the homes through Friday night and into Saturday, while a soils engineer will check the slide Saturday.

Worthy says none of the homes have been damaged, though a retaining wall behind one home has been destroyed.

The residents of the homes have not been ordered to evacuate.

The slide, which began Thursday afternoon, is being blamed on the recent rains.
