

Landslide on Sunset Boulevard

One of the westbound lanes of Sunset Boulevard was blocked off due to a landslide in Pacific Palisades Wednesday.

According to Los Angeles Fire Department Station 69, one of the westbound lanes of Sunset Boulevard was blocked due to a landslide in Pacific Palisades Wednesday morning.

As of 8 p.m., the lane was still blocked off along a corner turn just before the entrance to Will Rogers State Historic Park. There were barricades and lights along the road to alert drivers.

The landslide happened at around 10 a.m., according to the fire department. Firefighters had been out to the site multiple times throughout the day.

The LAFD said that city departments had been notified of the landslide.

The fire department said there had been no reports of traffic accidents due to the landslide.
