Small earthquake rattles Hayward Fault

An earthquake measuring 2.5 on the Richter scale struck the East Bay on Tuesday night, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.

The quake, centered between San Leandro and Oakland on the Hayward Fault, struck at 9:11 p.m. There were no immediate reports of damage.

The quake occurred in roughly the same area as a 3.2-magnitude temblor that struck Sunday night.
