Seismic retrofit for Antioch Bridge starts Monday

Pre-construction activities for the seismic retrofit of the Antioch Bridge on State Route 160 are scheduled to begin Monday, March 1.

The bridge connects Antioch in eastern Contra Costa County with Sherman Island in Sacramento County.

One-way traffic control will be in effect from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday nights. If necessary, the work will continue from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday night, according to a state Department of Transportation news release.

During the closure, traffic will be stopped at both sides of the bridge. Direction of travel will alternate during the hours that traffic controls are in effect.

Construction activities depend on the weather. Rain or fog could delay these closures.

Toll fees will be suspended during the closure. For any commuters who are accidentally charged on their transponders, tolls will be adjusted through administrative procedures.
